Moreway provide efficient Panbuster sub-soil machine

Roscommon company Moreway will display Erth Engineering's Panbuster sub-soiler (pictured) at the Ploughing Championships.

Certainly a machine of the times, considering our current run of weather, this sub-soiler has been designed for sub-soiling grassland, leaving a good finish to the soil once the job is completed.

Discs at the front of the machine cut the sod to give the sub-soiler legs easier access to the ground below, preventing the surface of the field from being torn up.

Following behind the discs, the four legs work to a depth of 9-12 inches, depending on the desired depth.

Each leg has a curved profile and is fitted with McConnel Shakerator points. A hydraulic reset allows the legs to negotiate obstacles below the surface. A hydraulically adjustable roller, with scraper, then helps reseal the surface to leave a good finish.
